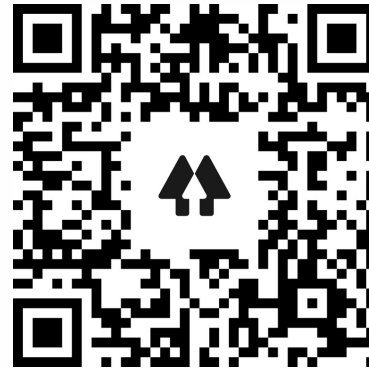

Teams

Registration of Teams
(3-4 members for each team)

October

Info Sessions

Each team member must attend **at least 2** sessions. If a team member is unable to attend the live session, a recording and survey will be sent.

November

Training

Teams will pitch their idea in front of other participants, entrepreneurs, and professors to receive feedback and advice.

December

Rehearsal

Teams will rehearse their pitch, check for technical difficulties, and receive final feedback.

December 12th

YNU Final

The final will be held on December 12th, 2020. Each team will have 10 minutes (6 min presentation, 4 min Q&A). The winning team will advance to the Regional Summits.

March

Regionals

YNU's winning team will have the opportunity to compete at one of the +25 Summits around the world, with the chance to qualify for the UN Final in New York.
